There's loads to do around Bundoran that won't cost you anything except your time and concentration...

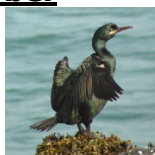
Why Not...?

See how many of these birds that visit Bundoran you can spot during your visit.

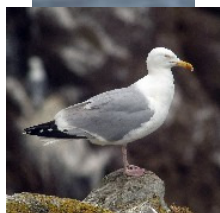
June - October



What: Black-headed Gull
Where: Everywhere
When: All year round
Call: Strident, down slurred call.
Eats: Insects and waste.



What: Shag
Where: Coastal cliffs and crevices.
When: All year
Call: Grunting
Eats: Wide range of fish



What: Herring gull
Where: Widespread on the coast and inshore
When: All Year
Call: Strident and loud
Eats: Predator & scavenger. Will eat waste.



What: Grey Plover
Where: Strictly coastal
When: July to end Sept.
Call: Call is mournful, whistle - 'peee-uu-ee'.
Eats: Intertidal invertebrates, esp. worms, molluscs and crustaceans.



What: Redshank
Where: Mudflats, estuaries and inlets
When: Late summer.
Call: A piercing "tew-hoo, tew-hoo"
Eats: Corophium sp. and nereid worms



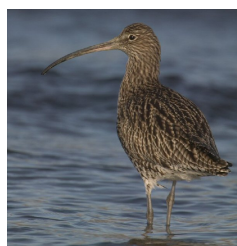
What: Greenshank
Where: Mostly coastal
When: July to late September
Call: Loud "tew, tew, tew"
Eats: invertebrates, particularly shrimps, crabs and small fish.



What: Ringed Plover
Where: Sandy coast
When: Peak numbers Aug - Oct.
Call: Mellow 'choo-ee'.
Eats: Variety of invertebrates, particularly polychaete worms and crustaceans.



What: Mute Swan
Where: Estuaries and inland.
When: All year but in larger numbers in late Summer
Call: Explosive snorting.
Eats: Water plants, amphibians, snails and insects.



What: Curlew
Where: Sandy coastline
When: All year round but esp late summer
Call: Ascending "cur-lee, cur-lee" whistle
Eats: Invertebrates, ragworms, crabs and molluscs.
